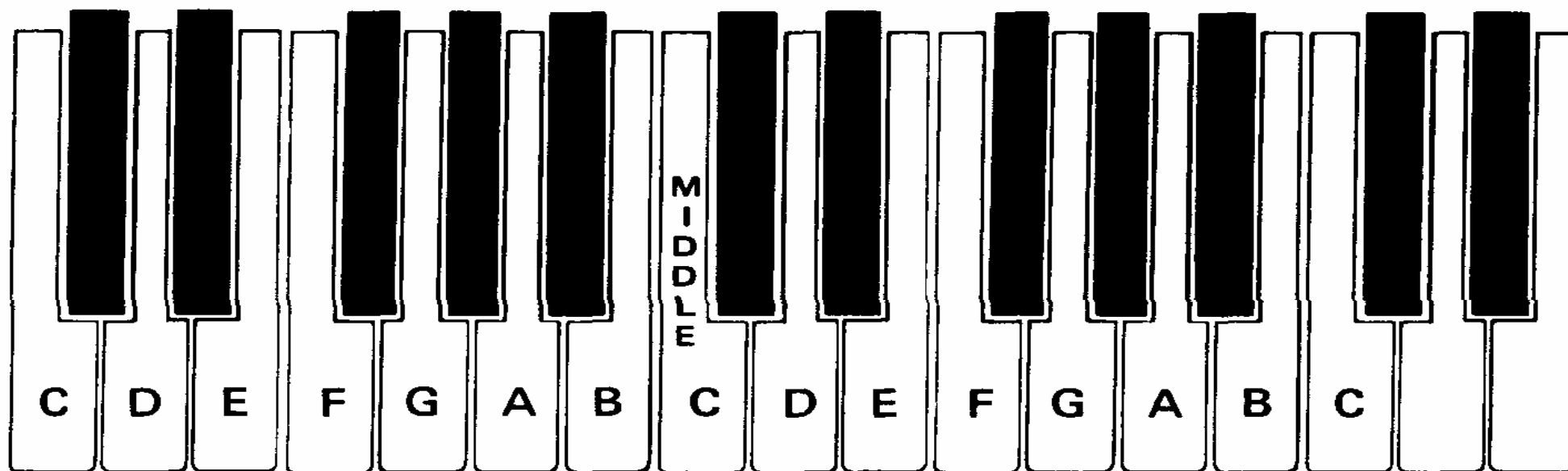


Quick view of part of the piano keyboard, names of notes and how they are written on sheet-music.

1. R.H. = notes usually played by the right hand. L.H. = notes usually played by the left hand.
2. # = 'sharp' meaning one semitone up in pitch. b = 'flat' meaning one semitone down in pitch.
3. Note that the same physical note on the piano can have two different names, depending on context.
(I have added the common 'black note' examples of this)
